

FLY FISH AUSTRALIA INC (TASMANIAN CHAPTER)
16TH TASMANIAN FLYFISHING CHAMPIONSHIPS Round one 25th & 26th of October 2009
Round two will be held on Northern Rivers on 7th & 8th February, 2009

To be eligible to win the championships or collect a medal anglers should fish both the lake and river competitions. Final placings will be decided using aggregate scores of both rivers and lakes. (You may still medal if you finish high enough in one competition)

Registering: You can register for one or both rounds of the competition.

Option One: Register rounds one & two. Entry fees with this option total \$150:00 plus FFA Fees (if applicable).
 (Entries for option one close 5pm Friday 10th OF October 2008)

Option Two: Register one round at a time. Entry fees with this option total \$90:00 per round plus FFA Fees (if applicable). Entries for option two close 5 pm Friday the 10th of October for Lakes & Friday the 23rd January, 2009 for rivers.

Please note: There are limited positions for the river competition due to availability of beats. Preference will be given to Tasmanians or those anglers that register and fish both lakes and rivers on a first come basis. It is anticipated 40 positions will be available for the river competition.

- (a) TO JOIN F.F.A. THERE IS A \$30 JOINING FEE PLUS \$50 ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION. Total \$80 (OPTIONAL) PLUS COMPETITION REGISTRATION FEE.
- (b) CURRENT MEMBERS PAY \$50 ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION PLUS COMPETITION REGISTRATION FEE. (unless already paid in Feb 08)

Once you have registered you will be obliged to pay the entry fee even if you pull out prior to the competition.
